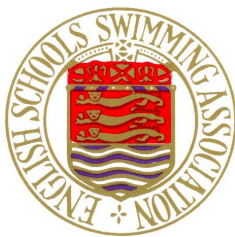

### ESSA PRIMARY SCHOOLS' RELAY CHAMPIONSHIPS DIVISION 3 QUALIFYING ROUND SATURDAY 8th MAY 2010

Dear \_\_\_\_\_,

Thank you for entering these championships in the past.

The Division 3 (Yorkshire, North and North East Lincolnshire) Qualifying Round will take place on **SATURDAY 8th MAY 2010** at the **HUDDERSFIELD SPORTS CENTRE, SOUTHGATE, HUDDERSFIELD, HD1 1TW** with the Warm up starting at 1.00 p.m. The start will be at 2.00 p.m. approx. with the finish around 5.00 p.m. All the events will be 4 x 25m Relay events.

***The depth of the pool at the deep end is 2mtrs and at the shallow end 0.9mtrs. For this competition Diving at the shallow end is prohibited. This is a Sports Centre Management Rule. Diving blocks will be available at the deep end***

The entry fee for this years competition is £20.00 per school this includes the affiliation fee.

**AGE GROUP RULES:** This competition is organised for children in Years 5 and 6 only, i.e. those who are **9 years old and Under 11 at midnight 31st August/1st September 2010 at the commencement of the academic year.**

**LARGE SCHOOLS:** These are schools which have, ***a combined total of 51 children, or more, in curriculum years 5 and 6.*** The events for these schools, which are for ***Boys and Girls*** separately, are:-

- i) a 4 x 25m Freestyle Relay and
- ii) a 4 x 25m Mixed Stroke Relay (this to be Backstroke, Breaststroke, Butterfly or Breaststroke, and Freestyle).

**SMALL SCHOOLS:** These are schools which have, ***no more than a combined total of 50 children in curriculum years 5 and 6.*** The events for these schools, which are for teams of ***4 Boys, 4 Girls, or a combination of Boys and Girls,*** are:-

- i) a 4 x 25m Freestyle Relay and
- ii) a 4 x 25m Mixed Stroke Relay (this to be Backstroke, Breaststroke, Freestyle (any stroke) and Front crawl).

Swimmers may swim in both Relay Events, if necessary.

Please see enclosed rules for more details.

**NATIONAL FINALS:** From this Qualifying Round; Two Boys' teams, Two Girls' teams and Two Small Schools' teams will be invited to represent Division 3 for each of the six events at the National Finals at Ponds Forge, Sheffield on Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> June 2010, in the afternoon. Initially the first two teams in each qualifying event will be invited. Should any school decline the invitation then a replacement will be found.
