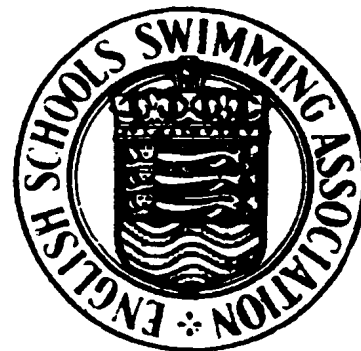

Thank you for your interest. Please find an entry form for English Schools Secondary School Team Swimming Championships.

These championships are held in 6 sections - 3 each for girls and boys. Ages are calculated as at midnight 31 August / 1 September **at the commencement of the school year**. So applying to those pupils who are in their correct year at school, the groups are:

JUNIOR (11 & u14)	01-09-96 to 31-08-99	Years 7, 8 and 9
INTER (14 & u16)	01-09-94 to 31-08-96	Years 10 and 11
SENIOR (16 & u18)	01-09-92 to 31-08-94	Years 12 and 13

- Your school has already been affiliated with the ESSA through the division.
- There is an entry fee of £4 per sectional team - Jun(b), Jun(g), Int(b), Int(g), Sen(b), Sen(g).
- Complete **entry form** and return to Roger Boyer **by Wednesday 3rd November 2010**.
- The **team list sheet** should be photocopied for **each** relay event you enter. All completed team sheets must be presented on the day of the trials.
- Schools can begin registration from 6.00 p.m. The first warm up starts at 6.25 p.m.

We are grateful for the City of Salford Recreation Dept for making the arrangements to allow us to use the 25m Broughton Pool - an excellent newly refurbished facility to secure fast times. Both inside and outside the pool will be covered by CCTV with a constant security patrol covering the areas designated for car parking.

There are ample places for spectators and supporters with bleacher seating on pool side for swimmers and team managers. This will provide the right conditions for a really noisy, competitive atmosphere. Spectators will be admitted at 6.15 p.m. There will be an entry fee for spectators.

**We also need officials and helpers to run the trials. Please e-mail in names of adults willing to help as soon as possible to Roger Boyer (roger.boyer@ntlworld.com).**

It is important that we get as many Division 7 school teams recording fast times to be among the leading qualifiers for the national finals which this year will be held in Division 7 at **Grand Central 50m Pool, Stockport** on the afternoon (1.30 p.m.) of Saturday **5th February 2011**.

**The Secondary School Team Relay Championships of England shall take place annually under A.S.A. Laws and under the following conditions.**

- 1. ELIGIBILITY**
  - (a) Only schools which are in affiliation with the English Schools' Swimming Association are eligible to compete.
  - (b) Competitors must be on the roll of the school entering the Championships and in full-time attendance there on the closing date for the divisional entries.
- 2. TRANSFERS**

Pupils transferred from one school to another will only be eligible to swim for the school for which they were first entered.
- 3. AGE**

Events shall be organised in six groups

(a) Boys aged 11 years and under 14 years	(d) Girls aged 11 years and under 14 years
(b) Boys aged 14 years and under 16 years	(e) Girls aged 14 years and under 16 years
(c) Boys aged 16 years and under 18 years	(f) Girls aged 16 years and under 18 years

The upper and lower age limits are applicable at every round of the Championships.  
Competitors may only swim on the appropriate age group.  
Age limits for these events shall be as at midnight 31st August/1st September at the commencement of the academic year of the championships.  
Competitors must present themselves in costumes conforming to ASA Law.
- 4. CONTROL**
  - (a) The sole control and management of the championships will be in the hands of Council.
  - (b) Arrangements for all stages of the championships up to, and including divisional rounds, will be in the hands of the Divisions. They will fix the closing dates and approve the officials.
  - (c) In the divisional rounds and divisional finals, schools will have at least two week's notice of the date, time and venue.
- 5. ENTRIES**
  - (a) Entries shall be limited to one Freestyle team of four swimmers and/or one Medley team of four swimmers per age group from each school except that co-educational schools will be permitted to enter boys' and girls' teams.
  - (b) Entries shall close on a date set by the Division and shall be made on the official entry form, which will be obtained from, and returned to the representative of the Division in which the School is situated. All entry forms must be countersigned by the Head teacher/Principal.
  - (c) The names, contact addresses and, if possible, telephone numbers of teachers responsible for the teams must accompany divisional entries.
  - (d) Competitors may swim in both the freestyle and medley relays.
- 6. TEAM LISTS**
  - (a) Before the commencement of each round a signed statement, showing the names with dates of birth of swimmers and certifying conformity with the conditions, will be handed to the organiser by a representative of each school taking part in that round.
  - (b) Substitution of reserves is permitted between each round of the Championships but the names and dates of birth must be included in the signed statement in 6(a) above.
- 7. NOTIFICATION**

Divisional representatives shall within 7 days of the Divisional rounds, or by December 1st (whichever is the earlier) submit full details of the Divisional results to the Hon. Secondary Team Organiser (nil returns must be sent where appropriate). The times submitted will be recorded to one hundredth of a second on the official forms for each school. Divisional representatives are also requested to send a full copy of the gala results.
- 8. CONDUCT OF THE CHAMPIONSHIPS**
  - (a) In preliminary rounds, the length of the course will be decided by the Division. The length of the pool for Divisional qualifying rounds will be 25 metres and with each swimmer completing 2 lengths.
  - (b) In the national finals, as the length of the course will vary according to the venue, the following distances will be swum:
    - (i) 33 1/3 metres pool - each swimmer will swim 2 lengths;
    - (ii) 50 metres pool - each swimmer will swim 1 length;
    - (iii) 25 metres pool - each swimmer will swim 2 lengths.
- 9. NATIONAL FINALISTS**
  - (a) The Hon. Secondary Team Organiser will select only on times recorded in a Divisional round, not less than the 12 fastest teams to swim in the National Finals. Where Divisions organise heats and finals for their rounds, only the heat times are to be submitted to the Hon. Secondary Team Organiser.

- (b) The Hon. Secondary Team Organiser will notify all finalists direct.  
All other schools may obtain results from their Divisional Representatives.
- (c) A requirement of qualifying to compete in the National Finals is the return of the acceptance form not later than the 1st January. After this date reserve teams may be invited.

#### 10. AWARDS

- (a) The schools attended by the teams placed 1st, 2nd and 3rd will be awarded a commemorative plaque to be held permanently; and each member of these teams will be awarded a Championship medal.
- (b) The remaining schools represented in the national finals will receive commemorative certificates.
- (c) The members of all teams competing in the national finals shall receive national finalists' certificates.
- (d) The following challenge trophies will be awarded to national winners in each event

- (e) Members of the fastest teams at the divisional finals will receive divisional certificates.
- (f) Council may issue awards at other levels of the championships at its discretion.

#### 11. EXPENSES

Each competing school shall be responsible for its own expenses.

#### 12. RESPONSIBILITY

A qualified school teacher, or suitable adult as approved by the Headteacher of the School, must accompany each team at all stages of the competition.
