PRIMARY INDIVIDUAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

2025 REGULATIONS

All competitors must be in full time education in a London Borough or City Corporation, Barking & Dagenham, Barnet, Bexley, Brent, Bromley, Camden, City of London, Croydon, Ealing, Enfield, Greenwich, Hackney, Hammersmith & Fulham, Haringey, Harrow, Havering, Hillingdon, Hounslow, Islington, Kensington & Chelsea, Kingston upon Thames, Lambeth, Lewisham, Merton, Newham, Redbridge, Richmond upon Thames, Southwark, Sutton, Tower Hamlets, Waltham Forest, Wandsworth, Westminster.

1. All competitors must be properly entered by and through their school, by the entry date.
2. All competitors' costumes and trunks must conform to SE Laws.
3. There will be **ONE AGE GROUP** for all events – competitors must be of Primary age at least 9 years and no more than 11 years on the date of the Final of the Championships 11th June 2025.

5. a) Each school may enter **TWO** competitors in each individual event.
b) A competitor may enter ONE 25m EVENT or UP TO TWO EVENTS IN THE 50m and 100m EVENTS (ie the 100m IM and one 50m event OR two 50m events).
c) Substitutes are allowed. It is the Team Manager's responsibility to inform Simon of any changes as early as possible prior to the gala or, if unavoidable, to ensure that the programme is amended on arrival at the gala.
6. There will be a short warm up prior to each gala.
7. All competitors must be accompanied by the "Teacher in Charge" who is responsible for his or her pupils at all times.
8. The attention of ALL TEACHERS is drawn to the following:
 - a) ALL COMPETITORS must be competent to swim 100m.
 - b) Each school must attend the galas with at least two members of staff, one of whom must be the "Teacher in Charge" and **one other to assist with the smooth running of the galas.** Jobs to be appointed on the day.

9. **The fee to enter this event (including affiliation) is £20 per school.** (An invoice will be sent to each school with instruction how to pay)

10. a) In each 25m event, the 12 fastest swimmers from the heats will swim in semi-finals on 22nd June. The six fastest swimmers from the semi-finals will then compete in the final on the same day.

b) In the 50m and 100m events, the 12 fastest swimmers from the heats will swim in the final with places decided on a HDW (Heat Declared Winner) basis.

11. Points are awarded at the Finals gala (11th June) as follows:

a) 50m and 100m events: 1st – 12 points, 2nd – 11 points.....12th – 1 point

b) 25m events: 1st – 7 points, 2nd – 6 points.....6th – 2 points. 7th to 12th – 1 point

12. Only swimmers who have competed in the Heats will be eligible to swim in the Finals

13. Trophies will be awarded to the top Boys' school, the top Girls' school and the top Mixed school

14. Medals will be awarded to the 3 fastest swimmers in the finals of each event.

15. Results will be sent out to schools.
