

Additional information will also be required later such as warm up slots; poolside accreditation for team managers/coaches who will be going poolside and payment of the swims.

Team Entry Payment

Unfortunately, with the rising costs for our national events and to ensure they remain at a quality standard we must charge schools for their swims. The charge is £25 per swim. A link will be sent out to you to pay this via stripe. This system will accept debit and credit card payments and also issue receipts. Video/Photography

The 29th Primary Teams' Championships will be live streamed during event and may be watched back after the event (great for assembly). In addition, we have an official photographer who will be taking photographs during the event (warm up and competition). If your school has a specific photograph in mind or wishes to guarantee they are photographed, you can contact the photographer directly to pre-order a package. Any photographs taken can be viewed and brought post event via the links that will be shared. This site is password protected. Please note any video or photos taken by ESSA may be used for publicity and media purposes.

It is schools' responsibility to make their teams and pupils aware of the streaming and photography policy. Should a family not want their child videoed or photographed they must e-mail the welfare team with their name, school and events entered to welfare@essa-mail.uk

Merchandise

Merchandise can be ordered pre-event. This can be personalised with your school's name, logo and swimmers' name. The deadline for personalised items is 1st June 2025. Non-personalised items can be brought on the day or pre-ordered via the merchandise page. If schools need invoices for payment this can be organised.

Towels and Swimming hats are also available for purchase at the event subject to availability

Accreditation

All volunteers and officials need to register for accreditation. If you have not been provided with a link to register, please contact accreditation@essa-mail.uk stating your role or school.

<u>ALL ADULTS</u> accompanying the team poolside need to complete the online form linked from the accreditation e-mail sent to schools i.e. any adult that will be with the swimmers in the swimmer seating area or poolside – it is not required for adults in the spectator balcony.

Accreditation will require you to:

- Provide a passport style photo
- Provide your DBS number and date of issue
- Provide a photo of your school photo ID or an authorisation letter from the head teacher:
 - o stating you are a teacher at the school or
 - stating they have authorisation to supervise the swimmers on the school's behalf [in the case of a non-staff member (e.g., a parent/club coach)]
- provide evidence to confirm that safeguarding training has been undertaken within the last 3 years
- Acceptable evidence includes a photocopy/screenshot of a suitable training certificate or an email from the school confirming the adult has conducted such training

Without completing the form adults will not receive a pass and security will prevent them entering the swimmer areas (changing rooms / swimmer balcony seating / poolside).

For each school, we allow two pool side passes to ensure the poolside is not overcrowded and to ensure the safety of all our participants. You will have also received a link from our technology and safeguarding partner Accredit Solutions to apply for your pass. You can collect these passes at the competition from the reception desk. Please note passes will only be given out if the team entry fee has been paid.

Day of the Event

ARRIVAL:

Travel By Public Transport

Schools are strongly advised to travel to and from Sheffield by public transport where possible.

The closest major train station is Sheffield Train Station which is within walking distance to Ponds Forge International Sports Centre.

To aid travel, we recommend you use the Travel South Yorkshire Planner.

Car Parking

Parking is not available at the Ponds Forge International Sports Centre, however, there is pay and display parking available at Q Park on Broad Street West which is a 5-minute walk across to the pool.

Designated disabled parking bays are located at the pool. Please ensure you have a valid disabled badge on display when parking in one of our designated disabled and accessible parking spaces.

Coach Parking

The Ponds Forge International Sports Centre has no parking facilities for mini busses or coaches. Schools will be required to make their own parking arrangements should they travel by coach/minibus

Accessing Ponds Forge

Entrance to the competition for competitors and spectators is via the main entrance at the front of the building. Spectator's tickets will be available for purchase at the entrance to the balcony which is situated past the café area. An entry fee of £10 per adults. Payment can be made in cash or via credit/debit card.

Security

Security may perform bags searches at the entrance. This applies to all (competitors, spectators and officials/helpers). If you are entering a safeguarded zone, you will be asked for your accreditation ID and this must always remain visible. This does include the participants accreditation. Spectators will be provided with an entry wristband that they must show for re-entry into the balcony area.

Changing Facilities

Changing rooms are situated on the lower level of the building. To access the changing room, you will go down the staircase to the left-hand side of the check in desks, walk around the side of the reception desk and into the changing rooms. Lifts are also available on the opposite side of the foyer from the stairs.

Due to the learn to swim programme, the changing village will be open to members of the public. Should you wish to use a secure area of the changing village, this is situated at the back right had corner (Red area on the map). **Only adults with accreditation will be able to gain access to this area.**

There are lockable lockers within these changing facilities. The lockers operate using a RF ID wristband which can be obtained from reception. Please note that as in many public buildings absolute security of the lockers cannot be guaranteed. **NO LARGE BAGS ARE ALLOWED ON POOLSIDE**.

Access to Poolside

Adults access to the field of play will be via the large glass doors to poolside. Adults will be required to show their Photo Accreditation in order to gain access onto the poolside. Adults are not allowed in the changing rooms to gain access to poolside. They must walk through the glass doors.

Registration

The team manager should register at the desk (near the entrance) called 'Schools Reception'. You should have already sent us your team sheet electronically prior to the competition you do not need to give us a printed copy of this. Your accreditation passes for members of staff poolside and the swimmers can also be collected here.

The Team Manager should also be prepared to show of consent forms for swimmers. These are school permission forms typically signed by parents/guardians in a format controlled by the school, to be retained by the Team Manager and available at all times. There is no specific ESSA format for these forms

Teams

Teams will be located around the competition pool by divisional name. Please ensure that swimmers do not encroach onto the field of play and remain back away from the pool to allow officials to perform their duties.

Swimmers are **NOT ALLOWED** into the balcony area at any time. This does include the public viewing areas as this is not a controlled safe zone.

Team Manager Meeting

On the Saturday there will be a Team Manager meeting at around 13:10, the meeting will be held in the open schools marshalling room which is located by the diving pit. The <u>Event Conditions</u> and <u>ESSA Technical Rules of swimming</u> can be found on the ESSA Website.

Marshalling/Call Room

Athletes should arrive race ready in the call rooms (see map on page 13) no later than four races/heats prior to their event. Coaches and Team Mangers are responsible for ensuring the athletes arrive in time for their races.

Competition heats and finals

Each event will consist of 3 heats. The fastest 10 English teams will make the A final and the next fastest 10 will make the B final of each event if we have sufficient officials.

Team Captains' Parade

At the opening of the event, we will have the team captains' parade. You will need to select one person from your team per event to represent your school/team in the parade, this includes captains from the Para Teams. T-shirts and shorts/train suit bottoms must be worn. They will need to report to the marshalling area at 1:20pm (by the diving pool) and please inform them what division they are from. The divisions will line up down the side of the pool as shown below and should report to the corresponding sides of the pool at the diving pit end at 1:20pm preparing for the walk on. Please note there will be no seating for athletes due to the numbers involved in the walk on.

Presentations

After the first section of the program (after the first set of finals), presentations will be made to the top three schools in the A final only and the top state school in each event which is called the President's Award. The president's award will be awarded first followed by the medals for that event. The swimmers will arrive at the podium having already received their medals and will only receive the main plaques and trophies on the podium. Please can the top three schools from the A final should be ready by the medal table in good time to keep the event running smoothly.

Message from the referees

Swim England laws have no allowance for any false starts, please ensure the swimmers know there is only one start. Bearing in mind that some swimmers may not be very experienced please can you remind the children not to climb over the starting pads and climb out the pool at the sides using the steps. Please will Team Managers note that an inadvertent touch on the timing pads may affect the time and result that comes up on the scoreboard. These times and places should not be taken as accurate until the result is confirmed by the referee accounting for any disqualifications or timing corrections necessary and given out by the announcer.

General Health & Safety

Volunteers, spectators, competitors and team staff are asked to be extra vigilant and take care not to leave the belongings unattended. Any concerns should be reported to event, venue or security staff. We are committed to working in a safe environment where everyone has a duty to look after themselves and each other. If you see something you consider to be a risk, don't ignore it but report it.

Wellbeing & First Aid

If you find that you become unwell during the event, please ensure you report it immediately to a member of the event staff. First aiders will be on hand to deal with any situation if it were to arise.

Safeguarding

Should you have any welfare concerns please raise these to the Technical Director or Event Director. You can also contact our welfare team via email at welfare@essa-mail.uk.

Following changes to Wavepower in 2024, the use of mobile phones is **strictly prohibited** in the changing areas. Please ensure that your athletes and team staff are aware of this.

In line with the venue requirements, no adults should be entering the changing rooms. To access the poolside, accredited adults should access poolside by the glass doors. They will not be allowed to walk through the changing rooms.

Food

There is a substantial café located at Ponds Forge where you will be able to purchase hot and cold food from. Swimmers and Coaches may bring food in their bags but should not eat on poolside. Please note, no hot drinks should be brought onto the poolside.

Spectators

Spectator tickets will be available to purchase upon arrival at the venue. The cost for entry will be £10.00 per Adult, £5.00 per child under 11yrs/concessions. Tickets will be sold on a first come first served basis.

Warm Up/Water Familiarisation/Swim Down

Schools' have been allocated their own warm up. This is shown on the website and on poolside. Team managers should report to the warmup marshal before entering their allocated lane at the appropriate time. Please note it is the team managers and coaches' responsibility for their athletes in the water. You may practise your starts and take overs but please do not climb over the timing pads and exit the water via the steps only. Once your allocated time is complete in the competition pool, your team may swim down in the pool behind for up to 15 minutes again under supervision of the team managers and coaches.

Please note the water familiarisation takes place in the main 25m pool where the competition will be held with the blocks and the warm up/swim down is the 2nd 25m pool next to the competition pool.

During the event, the 25m pool directly behind the competition pool may be used for warm up and swim down. At all times it is the team managers and/or coaches responsibility to supervise this. Swimmers may well be requested to leave the pool if they are miss behaving or not using the facility for its prime purpose. Please note if this facility is used inappropriately its total use may be withdrawn.


